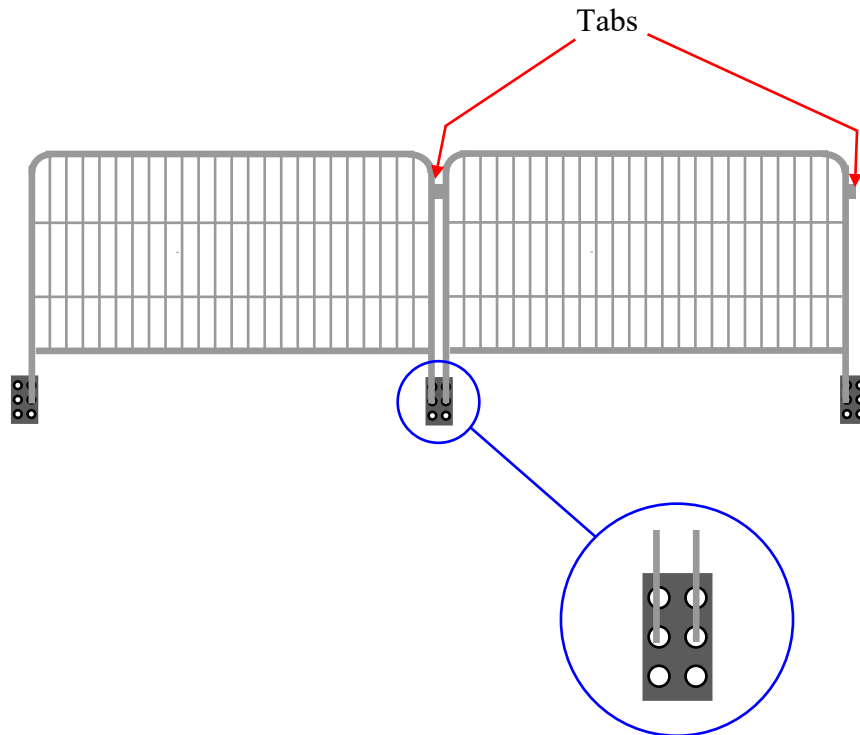


## Steel security mesh panels

Plan out the position of the fencing run and fix the first foot block into position. Place the first panel into the centre hole on the side the panels are going and fix the second foot into position. Take note that the holes in the blocks are made so that the tabs on the panels reach the next panel. Each panel facing the same way so no two tabs meet.



In a long straight span it is common to add bracing by triangulating the panels to secure the panels and stop them from being blown over by the wind. Where the fencing is following a curved path or turns corners it is not necessary to do this. It is also common that the panels are used as gates when the site is being accessed. This is easily achieved by leaving out the end block and swinging the panel to the required open position before gluing to the tab of the previous panel.
